Frequently asked questions:

How much does it cost to see one of your counsellors, as I am unemployed at the moment?

At Counselling Works sessions can cost less than £10 a session if you are unwaged or on benefits.

How long is a session?

One hour.

How often do I need to come for counselling?

Once a week is what most people choose.

I work shifts so can't attend sessions on the same day each week. Can you accommodate this?

How many sessions am I likely to need?

On average people come for between 6 & 8 sessions. It may take longer for more complex issues.

We have counsellors who work with children and adults. The service we offer

With 25 counsellors and psychotherapists we are likely to have a counsellor who is just right for you. Contact us to discuss your needs. When we have understood them we will contact a suitable counsellor for you. Counselling will normally start within 7 days. We have premises in Stony Stratford and Bedford. In addition counselling by telephone, FaceTime or Skype is also available.

Cost

The range is from £10 to £60 according to training and experience of the counsellor/psychotherapist. There is a one-off administration fee of £12, which is collected by credit/debit card along with the first session fee before counselling starts. We are grateful to our affiliates who give their time for free, or at a reduced fee to facilitate our "low cost service".

To reassure you:

Counsellors are required to be in Clinical Supervision, subject to an enforceable code of ethics and to have professional indemnity insurance.

We are registered under the Data Protection Act which provides a higher level of protection to clients than that offered by counsellors who are not registered.
